We pledged to eliminate plastic in our packaging by the end of 2022, expanded the Hasbro Toy Recycling program to six countries and continued to conduct full human rights and ethical sourcing reviews of our suppliers. We even became the first toy and game company to pilot the Higg Index to further measure the environmental impacts of our supply chain.
